WHAT INFORMATION CAN MY ORGANIZATION SEE WHEN I ENROLL MY DEVICE?

To further enhance security, XCL Group initiated the Cybersecurity Improvement Project. As part of this project, all devices accessing our M365 cloud services must be registered on VAS BYOD Portal and meet specific security requirements.

While **mobile phone registration** on the BYOD Portal **is not mandatory**, we encourage you to promptly register and ensure compliance to proactively support work processes and maintain a secure environment within our organization.

Step 1: Please sign out of your VAS account on related Microsoft 365 applications (excluding Microsoft Authenticator) on your phone before continuing.

Please ensure that the **Microsoft Authenticator** app is installed on your device. If it is not, kindly install the app as demonstrated in the attached image.

Next, go to the Google Play Store on your Android phone or tablet, find the software named **Intune Company Portal**, and install it.


